“Delta Adds New Weekly Nonstop Flight between Los Angeles and Sun Valley for 2015/16 Winter Season”

Sun Valley, ID.... Air service access to Sun Valley continues to increase with the announcement that Delta Air Lines has added a new weekly nonstop flight between Los Angeles and Sun Valley on Saturdays during the upcoming peak winter season. The flights will run from February 13 through April 2, 2016 using a 65 seat CRJ-700 regional jet.

Fly Sun Valley Alliance Director Carol Waller noted that the new Delta Air Lines nonstop service from Los Angeles will add additional access to Sun Valley from this large and important southern California market during the peak winter period.

An overview of air service to Sun Valley this coming winter is as follows:

Delta Air Lines:

- SLC-SUN: Daily year-round; three flights daily during peak winter periods of December 19-January 10 (except 12/24-25, 1/1), February 20, 27 and March 3-April 3, two flights daily other periods
- LAX-SUN: Saturdays only February 13-April 2

Alaska Airlines:

- SEA-SUN: Daily from December 17 – March 28; additional flight December 24, 26-January 3
- LAX-SUN: Daily from December 17 – March 28

United Express:

- SFO-SUN: Daily from December 17 - March 28
- DEN-SUN: Daily from December 17- January 4; Wednesday/Saturday from January 5 – February 7; 5x week (Thursday-Monday) February 8-March 28
