“Sun Valley’s seasonal nonstop flights begin in December”

Denver added to the growing list of winter nonstop flight cities

Getting to and from Sun Valley (SUN) this winter will be easier than ever with nonstop flights from five major cities – Denver, Los Angeles, San Francisco, Salt Lake City and Seattle.

Fly Sun Valley Alliance, along with Friedman Memorial Airport and the Sun Valley Resort, announced the following air service schedule for flights to Sun Valley this coming winter:

Alaska Airlines:

- SEA-SUN: Daily from December 13 – March 29
Five flights per week, no Tuesday/Wednesday, Jan 12 –25
- LAX-SUN: Daily from December 15 – March 29
Five flights per week, no Tuesday/Wednesday, Jan 12 –25

United Express:

- SFO-SUN: Daily from December 18 - March 29
Five flights per week, no Tuesday/Wednesday, Jan 6-Feb 10* (**Will operate Tuesday, Jan 20*)
- DEN-SUN: Daily from December 18 – January 5
Saturday only from January 10 – February 7; Wednesday/Saturday from February 11 – March 28

Delta Air Lines:

- SLC-SUN: Daily year-round; three flights daily during peak winter periods, and two flights daily during other periods

Fly Sun Valley Alliance Director Carol Waller noted that since some of the flights are not operating daily during non-peak periods in the season, that a search of the online calendars on the individual airline websites is the best way to see the flight schedules by day of the month.
