“Sun Valley announces 2026-27 winter season flight schedule which includes nonstop service to eight cities”

Fly Sun Valley Alliance (FSVA), in partnership with Sun Valley Resort and the Friedman Memorial Airport (SUN), has announced that the SUN airline flight schedule for the 2026-27 winter season will offer daily nonstop flights to eight cities – Chicago, Denver, Los Angeles, Phoenix, San Diego, San Francisco, Seattle, and Salt Lake City - with additional frequency on the Denver and Seattle routes.

American Airlines, which began operations at SUN last winter, will offer daily nonstop service from Phoenix (PHX) and Chicago (ORD) to SUN for the winter season, beginning December 17. Both flights will run daily December 17- April 5. Starting in December, American Airlines will be using the Embraer E175 aircraft, providing a major improvement in reliability for SUN travelers.

Delta Air Lines, which serves Sun Valley year-round, will offer three daily nonstop flights from Salt Lake City (SLC), plus nonstop flights from Seattle (SEA) and Los Angeles (LAX) daily from December 19 - January 3 and on Saturdays from January 9 - March 27.

United Airlines will operate its daily year-round nonstop service from Denver (DEN) to two flights daily from December 17 - April 30 and will offer daily nonstop flights from Chicago (ORD) from December 17 – March 27. United’s nonstop flights to Los Angeles (LAX) will run one to two times daily from December 1 - March 27 and its nonstop San Francisco (SFO) flights will run one to two times daily from daily from December 17 - March 27.

Alaska Airlines, which flies nonstop from Seattle (SEA), will offer one to two daily flights from November 1 - April 13, and four weekly flights from April 14 - 30. Alaska will also offer nonstop flights to San Deigo two to three times per week from December 18 - March 28.

American, Alaska, Delta and United have scheduled all SUN flights with the Embraer E175 aircraft. Over the past five years, E175 flights at SUN have averaged a 98% completion rate. This reliability means less diversions, fewer delays, and more predictable travel planning for SUN travelers.

“This winter our local residents and visitors will have excellent air access options with nonstop service to eight major cities and one stop connectivity to over 300 domestic and international destinations from our small but efficient and reliable airport,” said Carol Waller, executive director of Fly Sun Valley Alliance. “Sun Valley truly is “One stop to the World.”
